


Volunteering Opportunities

with Northumberland County Public Schools




Thank you for your interest in volunteering with Northumberland County Schools.

As a result, all potential volunteers must be approved through the Background Investigation Bureau, LLC (BIB) before volunteering. Additional steps within the background check process may be needed.

If you would like to volunteer, please take the following steps:

- 1. Contact the appropriate contact person for the volunteer opportunity of your interest. (See below.)
- 2. Complete the Background Investigation Bureau, LLC (BIB) application online at https://bib.com/secure-volunteer/NORTHUMBERLAND-COUNTY-PUBLIC-SCHOOLS/?lang=en
- 3. NCPS staff member or an administrator will contact you after we receive the results of the thorough background check.
- 4. If you are approved, you will work directly with the contact person to set up a volunteer schedule.
